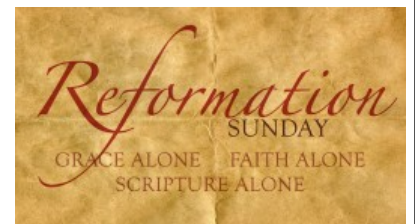
## Pastoral Ponderings
