Church World Services Collection

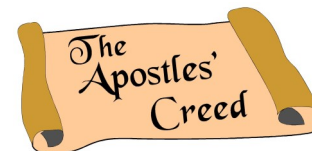
The Presbyterian Women are collecting school supplies for Church World Service (CWS) for one more week! Requested Supplies are
