### Minister Musings...from Pastor Lisa

Some people I know keep a gratitude journal. Every evening they write out several things that happened to them during the day that made them especially grateful. One friend says that it's become such a routine that it's like brushing her teeth before bedtime. She'd feel incomplete without it.

I love the idea of a gratitude journal. Oprah keeps one. So does Tim Tebow and Ricky Skaggs. I heard this week that Billy Graham kept one for years, amassing shelves of journals in his home office. Catherine, Her Royal Highness the Duchess of Cambridge (aka Kate Middleton) keeps a daily *and* a weekly journal.

Best-selling author and expert on co-dependency and substance abuse Melody Beattie says, "*Gratitude turns what we have into enough.*" What I take this to mean - at least for me - is, if we can sit still long enough to truly recognize our abundance, then we have a fairly good chance of enjoying life a whole lot more. The scarcity that so many of us claim ("if only I had this or that things would be better") might vanish and in its place might just come a greater sense of calm and peace.

Naming our blessings is relatively easy. Recognizing our abundance and being grateful is a little more difficult. What I'm going to do this week, and what I invite you to do with me, is look our abundance square in the eye and be grateful for it. Being grateful is more than saying "thanks God" - it's also turning all that we have into enough. Chances are, when we live grateful lives, we also learn the liberating truth that in God, WE are enough, too.

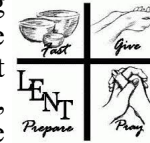


**Thanks to You!**
