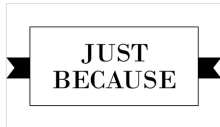
Highlights of the November 4, 2018 Session Meeting

1. The Session meeting was opened with devotions and prayer by Elder Lori Staley. Present at the meeting were our Moderator, The Reverend Kate Rascoe, Ann Grisdale (Clerk of Session) and Ruling Elders Margaret Nelson, Marian French, Cindy Wilkins, Irene Mertens, Morgan Saeler, Lori Staley, Sharon Baroncelli, Jane Runyon, George Swecker, Diane Cook, and George Shaffer. Ruling Jerry Germroth was excused. Also in attendance was church treasurer Ray Powell.
2. The minutes of the September 23, 2018 stated meeting were approved and the treasurer's report was received as information.
3. Elder Jane Runyon was elected commissioner to the November 27th Presbytery meeting to be held at Strasburg Presbyterian Church.
4. The Session pledged \$8066 as the Presbytery Asking for 2019.
5. Pastor Kate discussed her role as interim and briefed the Session on her calendar for the month of November.
6. The Nominating Committee is preparing the slate of elders for the Class of 2021 and the Session called a special congregational meeting on Sunday, November 25, 2018 for the purpose of electing this slate.
7. The Membership Ministry Team is reviewing the active membership list.
8. The Stewardship Team is preparing for Stewardship Sunday on November 18, 2018.
9. The next meeting of the Session is scheduled for December 9th at 12:30 p.m.
10. There being no further business, Pastor Kate closed the meeting with prayer.

Just Because Collection on November 18

This year, Rev. Karen Caspersen started Just Because to support local teachers. They are a nonprofit organization that recognizes that teachers and staff often feel overwhelmed and unrecognized.
