Renovation status: still waiting on power company to install pole and transformer on church property. Easement has been granted, electrician has been contracted and company has been contracted for renovation. The new two door cooler has been received and will replace a very old two door cooler we have had since the food pantry started in 1987. Due to the uncertainty of the start of renovation, we are trying to keep the inventory of food down. This will help us when we have to move the food inventory from the shelves in the food pantry and also our storeroom to a temporary location in the building..
