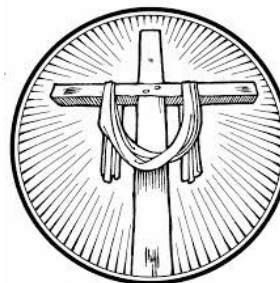

Great Prayer of Thanksgiving and The Lord's Prayer

Leader: The Lord be with you

People: And also with you

L: Lift up your hearts.

P: We lift them to the Lord.

L: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

P: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

L: It is right and our great delight to praise you, O God.

You did not reject us, but continued to call us and claim us as your own. Therefore we praise you, joining our voices with choirs of angels and with all the faithful of every time and place, who forever sing to the glory of your name:
