

FOR THINE IS THE KINGDOM, THE POWER, AND THE CLORY FOR EVER AND EVER. AMEN

One of the first things I remember being taught to memorize was the Lord's Prayer. Of course, I had learned and memorized other things the ABCs, our address and phone number, basic math skills that were drilled into me. The Prayer, though, was handed to me on a bookmark, and I was *asked* to learn it. I grew up in church,

and had already learned its rhythm, but not fully known the words. It was years later that I realized that it was not just an important prayer, but actually a scripture passage (Matthew 6:9-15)! Matthew 6 includes many instructions regarding prayer. Just before Jesus says, ⁹ "Pray then in this way," he implores his followers:

"When you are praying, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do; for they think that they will be heard because of their many words." (Matt 6:7). A challenge for me, in my walk of faith, is to not turn the words and rituals of my faith into heaps of empty phrases. Sometimes this requires new words – different translations, music foreign to my ears... Sometimes I am helped simply by a change in setting – reading the Bible outdoors, or praying familiar words in new rhythm. As uncomfortable as the initial disorientation may be, I hope to be able to grow into the new spaces these changes create. I pray to move beyond emptiness to fullness with God.
