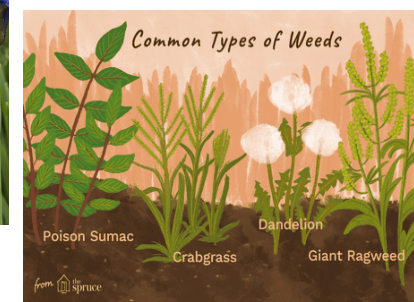

## Highlights of the January 20, 2019 Session Meeting

1. The Session meeting was opened with prayer by Pastor Kate. Present at the meeting were our Moderator, The Reverend Kate Rascoe, Ann Grisdale (Clerk of Session) and Ruling Elders Margaret Nelson, Morgan Saeler, Sharon Baroncelli, Marian French, Diane Cook, Jane Runyon, Malinda Johnston, Becky Fadely, Jerry Germroth and George Shaffer. Ruling Elders George Swecker and Cindy Wilkins were excused. Also in attendance was church treasurer Ray Powell.
2. The minutes of the December 9, 2018 stated meeting and the January 6, 2019 special meeting were approved and the treasurer's report was received as information.
3. The following actions were approved by the Session:
  - a. The Session calendar for 2019.
  - b. The book Spiritual Leadership for Church Officers by Joan S. Gray for study by the Session.
  - c. The appropriation of \$2955 from the Lessie Sine fund to cover benevolence expenses for the year ending 2018.
  - d. The presentation of the 2019 WPC Budget was approved.
  - e. The election of Ray Powell as church treasurer, Cindy Wilkins as assistant treasurer and Ann Grisdale as clerk of session for the year 2019.
  - f. The election of Ruling Elders Jane Runyon and Diane Cook as primary and alternate commissioners respectively to the February Presbytery meeting.
  - g. The request of the Presbyterian Women to sponsor a yard sale to be held on Saturday, April 6, 2019 with the proceeds designated for the renovation project of the upstairs unfinished room with any excess profits to go to the Building Fund.

h. Church wide fundraising was approved for the renovation project of the unfinished upstairs room and for the purchase of air conditioning units for the preschool with any excess funds raised for these projects to go to the Building Fund.

i. The next meeting of the Session is scheduled for February 10, 2019 at 12:30 p.m.

There being no further business, the meeting was closed with prayer.

## BREAD OF LIFE FOOD PANTRY JANUARY TOTALS

1. WE GAVE OUT 3755 POUNDS OF FOOD TO 50 FAMILIES CONSISTING OF 148 INDIVIDUALS.
2. AGAIN THIS MONTH THE NUMBER OF CLIENTS REQUESTING FOOD WAS LOWER THAN EXPECTED.
3. AS REQUIRED BY THE BLUE RIDGE AREA FOOD BANK IN WINCHESTER WE RENEWED OUR CONTRACT ON 4 JANUARY FOR 2019. THIS REQUIRES US TO OPERATE WITHIN THE GUIDELINES STIPULATED BY BY THE FOOD BANK. WE ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND TRAINING SESSIONS BY THEM AND TO CONDUCT OUR OWN TRAINING SESSIONS REGARDING FOOD SAFETY AND CIVIL RIGHTS REQUIREMENTS. THIS CONTRACT IS AVAILABLE FOR YOUR REVIEW UPON REQUEST.
