

WE PRAY THAT THE RENOVATION OF THE COMPLETE BUILDING WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED BY THE FALL.

Women in Community 2019 Retreat


We're young. We're middle aged. We're old. We're mothers. We're daughters. We're single. We have families. We are women of faith. We are engaged in the world. We build and live community.
