## BREAD OF LIFE FEBRUARY TOTALS

\*WE GAVE OUT 4030 POUNDS OF FOOD TO 62 FAMILIES CONSISTING OF 189 INDIVIDUALS.



\*WE HAD 49 FAMILIES ON TUESDAY AND ONLY 16 FAMILIES ON THURSDAY PROBABLY RELATED TO THE WEATHER ON WEDNESDAY.

\*WE WILL BE HOSTING A BRIEFING FOR THE COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP PROGRAM – COMMUNICATION AND NON-PROFIT COMMUNITY MEETING ON FRIDAY, 8 MARCH 2019, 8 TO 10 AM AT WUMC.

\*WE HAVE MOVEMENT ON THE RENOVATION OF THE CHURCH BUILDING THAT IS OUR HOME. THE RENOVATION HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE TRUSTEES AND THE CHURCH COUNCIL. THE TRUSTEES ARE DOING SOME PRELIMINARY WORK IN THE PART WHERE WE WILL EVENTUALLY MOVE TO. A CONTRACT HAS BEEN SIGNED FOR THE ROOF TO START IN APRIL WHICH IS EXPECTED TO TAKE ABOUT A MONTH. ONCE THAT IS COMPLETE WORK IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN ON OUR PART OF THE BUILDING. WHEN THAT IS READY WE WILL MOVE TO THE NEWLY RENOVATED PART WHICH MEANS MOVING ALL OF OUR EXISTING EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES. ONCE WE HAVE MOVED INTO THE EXISTING PORTION OF THE BUILDING THAT WE ARE IN WILL BE DEMOLISHED. WE EXPECT TO BE ABLE TO OPERATE EACH MONTH WHILE THE REST OF THE BUILDING AND PARKING LOT IS FINISHED. WE PRAY THAT THE RENOVATION OF THE COMPLETE BUILDING WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED BY THE FALL.

## Women in Community 2019 Retreat

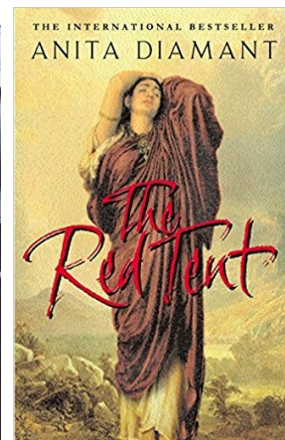
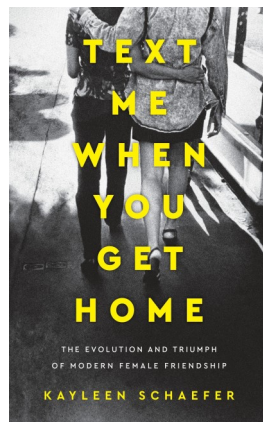
We're young. We're middle aged. We're old. We're mothers. We're daughters. We're single. We have families. We are women of faith. We are engaged in the world. We build and live community.
