Headlines from the September 2019 Session Meeting

- The Session received a visit and report from Preschool Director Stephanie Dysart. They are off to a great year and we were reminded how much this program means to the community.
- Following the update the Session discussed ways the church could communicate activities of the church with the Preschool families. We were reminded that our Preschool Liaison is Vicky Germroth.
- The Session agreed to broaden the scope of the ESL/Education (Preschool included) Enhancement project and fundraising efforts to include a sump pump that would work in case of electrical failure.
- The Trustees of the Session reported signing banking documents to allow the new Treasurer signing ability.
- Treasurer Jennifer Saeler gave the treasury report and the Session received it as information. She was praised for the countless hours spent during the transition.
- Elder Cindy Wilkins gave a report on church finance and spoke about bringing us up to date with required church audits. The Session agreed unanimously to contact a local church auditor whose fee is minimal, to bring us up to date.
- Clerk of Session Heather Ashley reported an estimated 10 years of records are now digitally saved but there is a need to safeguard our physical church records. Currently records from the 1800s till present are housed in a closet and are unprotected from fire/water damage. She stated a need for a fireproof safe. The Session asked that she request an email sent to see if a church member may have such to donate. The Clerk further explained her training continues with Clerk training at the Big Event.

- Pastor Kate shared her Transitional Pastor Report given to the CPT and provided an additional letter to the Session. The Session learned that we could elect her for another year and unanimously approved to extend her contract till October 31, 2020.
- Commissioner Jane Runyon gave the Presbytery report. Elder Diane Cook will serve as alternate commissioner for the next stated meeting November 19, 2019 at 9:30 am at Opequon.
- Elder training continued with Reverend Rascoe leading discussion of the book *Spiritual Leadership for Church Officers*.
- In new business, the Session is currently reviewing the church membership roles the Nominating Committee reported it is difficult to find members willing to step into Elder roles, the Session will propose changes to our bylaws to a three person class instead of a four. By law changes will also be brought up during an upcoming congregational meeting so that church communication and meetings may utilize various forms of technology as needed. And the Session was made aware of a facility rental application and received the details as information.
