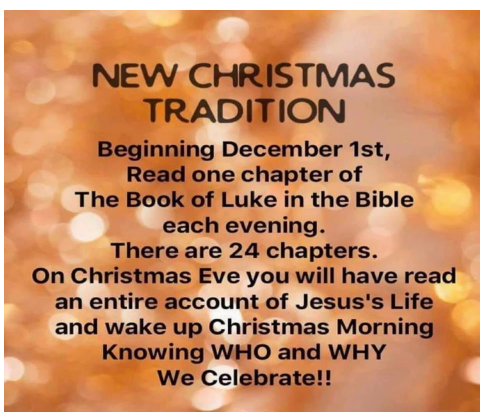
**2019 Holiday Season

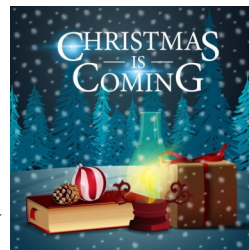
