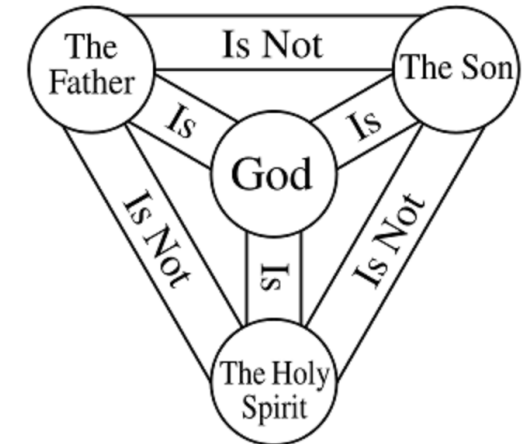
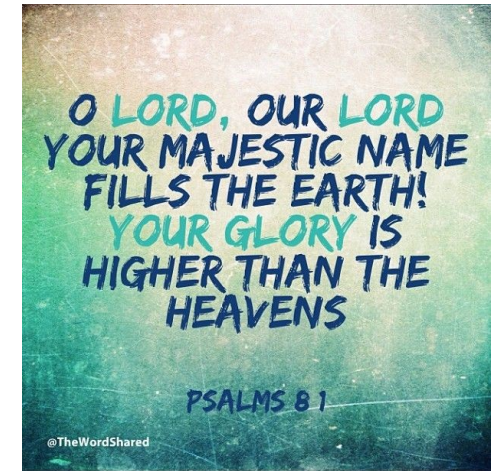

## Highlights of the June 9, 2019

### Session Meeting

1. The Session meeting was opened with prayer by Elder Jane Runyon. Present at the meeting were the Moderator, The Reverend Kate Rascoe, Ann Grisdale (Clerk of Session) and Ruling Elders Margaret Nelson, Jerry Germroth, George Shaffer, Marian French, Diane Cook, Jane Runyon, Becky Fadely and Cindy Wilkins. Ruling Elder George Swecker, Sharon Baroncelli, Malinda Johnston, and Morgan Saeler were excused. Also in attendance were Heather Ashley, incoming clerk; and Hal Ladehoff and Steve Simons, representatives of the Presbyterian Men.

2. The Presbyterian Men (PM) made a presentation to the Session in the ESL room in the Education Wing. The Session was updated on the progress of the ESL renovation. A report of the PM accomplishments for 2018 and 2019 was provided. Jerry Germroth, currently the president of PM, talked about the organization, their monthly breakfast meetings, and some of the projects of the PM. The Moderator then opened the discussion to the Session. One area of concern that the PM have noted is the sound system in the sanctuary. They have met with an expert on church sound systems to evaluate the needs of our particular church and fellowship hall. The estimate for accomplishing an upgraded system that would tie together the sanctuary and the fellowship hall would be around \$20,000 although an exact figure would depend on the level of upgrades implemented. This would be an expensive endeavor but the Session concurred that this should be a top priority and one which the Session should take the lead on.

3. The Presbyterian Women (PW) presented their report. Representatives of the PW included Diane Cook and Jane Runyon. The Session was provided a report of the 2018 and 2019 activities of the PW.

4. The minutes of the May 19, 2019 Stated meeting and the May 26 2019 Special meeting were approved. The Session also received reports from various ministry teams and the Presbyterian Men and Presbyterian Women.

5. The following actions were approved by the Session:

a. Called the annual congregational meeting for Sunday, July 14 following morning worship for the purpose of receiving ministry team reports and electing the Nominating Committee.

b. By common consent, elected Margaret Nelson as the alternate commissioner to the August 24 Presbytery meeting. (Jane Runyon serves as the elected primary commissioner for 2019).

c. Concurred with the Trustee recommendation to award Ashley Everhart and Whitney Good each a \$1000 scholarship from the Symons Shaffer Scholarship Fund.

d. For 2019 added Gary Yew and Roger Wilkins to the counting teams to replace Jennifer Saeler and Heather Ashley and added Heather Ashley to the substitute list.

e. Funded \$150.00 to accomplish background checks on all church employees and church officers.

f. Elected Heather Ashley as Clerk of Session.

g. The next meeting of the Session is scheduled for Sunday, September 8, 2019 at 12:30 p.m. and will be led by the Preschool and Finance and Stewardship Ministry Teams.

There being no further business, the meeting was closed with prayer by Elder Jane Runyon.
