Highlights of the May 19, 2019 Session Meeting

*The Session meeting was opened with prayer by Elder George Shaffer. Present at the meeting were the Moderator, The Reverend Kate Rascoe, Ann Grisdale (Clerk of Session) and Ruling Elders Margaret Nelson, Jerry Germroth, George Shaffer, Marian French, Diane Cook, Jane Runyon, Malinda Johnston, Morgan Saeler, Sharon Baroncelli, Becky Fadely and Cindy Wilkins. Ruling Elder George Swecker was excused. Also in attendance was Heather Ashley who is training to be the new clerk.

*An omnibus motion was made to receive all reports in the Session packet and to approve the minutes of the April 14, 2019 stated meeting. The motion passed.

*Pastor Kate welcomed Herman Klainer to the meeting. Herman was received into membership by the Session by Letter of Transfer from the Woodstock United Methodist Church. The right hand of fellowship was extended to Herman by the members of Session.

*Roger Wilkins was received into membership by Reaffirmation of Faith. Roger, Herman and Gretchen Smith-Klainer will be welcomed into the congregation during morning worship on Sunday, May 26th.

*Shelley Schechtel was removed from our active roll as she has joined St. John Bosco Roman Catholic Church, Woodstock, Virginia.

*Elders took Communion to the residents of Pine Meadow and to Ray Powell as an extension of the congregation's receiving the Sacrament of Communion on Sunday, May 5.

*As part of her report, Pastor Kate addressed her upcoming discussion of the CAT survey with the congregation. She wants to widen the conversation to include people who may have been hesitant to participate in the survey. Her second point of discussion was letting the congregation know the elements of the search process for a new minister.

She emphasized the more knowledge the congregation has the more trust they will have in the system and in the Pastor Nominating Committee. And finally, Pastor Kate discussed her goal of building the Session's confidence in their spiritual leadership by continuing to provide them with tools and resources.

*The Session agreed to the following changes to their calendar: The June 9th meeting will begin at 11:30 a.m., the Session will not meet in July or August and Stewardship and Finance Ministry Team will lead the meeting in September.

*At this time Elder Diane Cook of the Education Ministry Team presented her report, Jessica Jones, our Nursery Care Provider, is doing an excellent job developing Sunday School programs. She has programs planned through the summer months. Diane asked for ways to improve our adult Sunday School program. There were many suggestions and ideas on ways to be creative in our approach to education. You will be hearing more from the Education Ministry Team as they seek to find out what the congregation is looking for and offering some new and innovative ways to increase our Biblical knowledge.

*Jennifer Saeler was elected as the church treasurer effective immediately. Her term of office will be for the remainder of 2019 calendar year.

*Stewardship and Finance Ministry Team was charged with developing an appropriate recognition for Ray Powell on behalf of the Session and congregation.

*The next meeting of the Session is scheduled for Sunday, June 9, 2019 at 11:30 p.m. and will be led by the Presbyterian Women and the Presbyterian Men.

*There being no further business, the meeting was closed with prayer by Pastor Kate.
